

Calendar

Here you will find all the important dates in anticipation of the election on November 7th, 2021.

September 7th, 2021

First day to file nomination papers and to authorize an independent candidate.

Note that nomination papers shall be filed at the office of the returning officer. Monitor the public notice of election to determine the days and times the returning officer is available for this purpose.

October 1st, 2021: Last day to file a declaration of candidacy. Deadline is set at 4:30 p.m.

October 1st, 2021 : Proclamation of the elected candidates and of the candidates elected without opposition.

Octobre 5th, 2021 : Last regular council meeting

Between October 6th and October 10th, 2021 (official date to be confirmed): Meeting with the candidates (or by videoconference) to agree on the operating rules.

From October 16th to 28th, 2021 (Official dates tbc): Possible dates of the sessions where the review board of the electoral list will sit.

Before October 30th, 2021 : Mailing of the reminder card to each voter indicating the polling stations and candidates.

Advance poll

Sunday, October 31th, 2021 from 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. (times to be confirmed)

Jour du vote par anticipation de 9h30 à 20h. Tout électeur inscrit sur la liste électorale peut voter par anticipation. Il suffit de se présenter à l'endroit de vote prévu avec la carte de rappel et l'une des pièces d'identité suivantes :

Advance poll day from 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. Any elector registered on the electoral list can vote in advance. All you have to do is go to the designated voting place with the reminder card and one of the following identification items:

- Health insurance card issued in plastic form issued by the Quebec Health Insurance Plan
- Driver's license or probationary plastic license issued by the Quebec Public Automobile Insurance Plan (SAAQ)
- Canadian Passeport
- Certificate of Indian Status
- Canadian Armed Forces Identity Card

Possibility of holding a 2nd day of advance polling on October 30th, depending on the health measures in force.

Postal voting

No later than Friday, November 5 Last day to receive postal voting envelopes.

Voting Day

Sunday, November 7th, 2021 from 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Report to the designated voting place with the reminder card and one of the following identification items:

- Health insurance card issued in plastic form issued by the Quebec Health Insurance Plan
- Driver's license or probationary plastic license issued by the Quebec Public Automobile Insurance Plan (SAAQ)
- Canadian Passeport
- Certificate of Indian Status
- Canadian Armed Forces Identity Card
